Purpose

This document describes how to upload and install new dashlets in Nagios XI.

Components Overview

Components are optional extensions to Nagios XI that can be installed by administrators to provide enhanced functionality to both end-users and administrators alike. For example, components are available for providing new notification methods and UI enhancements and modifications.

Nagios XI components are distributed in ZIP files that can be easily uploaded and installed to Nagios XI. You do not have to open or modify the ZIP files, and you usually don't have to do any additional installation steps beyond uploading the ZIP file to Nagios XI.

How to Install Components in Nagios XI

1. Navigate to Admin > System Extensions > Manage Components.

- 2. Click the Browse button to select the new component you want to install.
- 3. Select the component file (.zip extension) that you previously downloaded using the window that appears and click **Open**.



4. Click the **Upload & Install** button to upload the component.

5. Once the component is uploaded, you will receive a message saying it was installed, and it will appear in the list of components.

NOTE: Some components are required by Nagios XI and cannot be deleted.



You will receive an informational message once the component has been removed from Nagios XI.

NOTE: If you are developing a component for Nagios XI and the component produces errors which leaves Nagios XI inoperable, you will have to manually delete the components' directory in /usr/local/nagiosxi/html/includes/components/. Make sure you only remove the subdirectory associated with the problematic component.
