

- 2. Add your information to the form.



3. In the VMware section click Download Now in the Workstation Pro section.





Installing the Nagios XI OVA in VMware


1. Open VMware Workstation Pro.





2. Click File > Open.




3. Select your newly downloaded and extracted Nagios XI OVA file, then click Open.



4. Change the name and/or the location as you desire, then Click Import.




5. The OVA will now begin to import.

6. When complete, the importing popup will disappear, you will then click **Power on**.




7. Once the machine fully powers on the welcome banner, it will have your IP address, and the default root user password for command line login.




8. Open your browser of choice and go to the URL given after Access Nagios XI at in the banner.

9. Click **Access Nagios XI** to begin configuring.





11. This screen is where you will configure the nagiosadmin user account used to access the website, change the options as you desire. Once you have everything configured, Click **Finish Install**.






12. If you haven't already, please ensure that you have your password saved in some location, ideally a password manager.
