
## How To Monitor FTP Servers With Nagios XI 2024 And 2026

#### **Purpose**


This document describes how to monitor an FTP server with Nagios XI using the FTP Server monitoring wizard.

### **Using the FTP Server Wizard**

 To begin using the FTP Server wizard navigate to Configuration > Configuration Wizards, and search for 'FTP', and click the FTP Server wizard



2. In Step 1, enter the IP or FQDN for the FTP server you would like to monitor, then click Next.





## How To Monitor FTP Servers With Nagios XI 2024 And 2026

- 3. In **Step 2**, select the checks you'd like to run:
  - Host Name This is the name you would like associated with your FTP server in Nagios XI
  - FTP server This checks the FTP server to ensure it can be contacted by clients
    - Port FTP is by default on port 21
    - Use SSL If you would like to use SSL
  - **File Transfer** Check the FTP server to ensure a test file can be uploaded and deleted from the root directory.
  - Username and Password the Linux system username and password for the file transfer test.

After selecting your checks, click **Next** to proceed.



4. Complete the wizard by choosing the required options in **Step 3 – Step 5**.

To finish up, click on **Finish** in the final step of the wizard. This will create the new host and services and begin monitoring.

Once the wizard applies the configuration, click the **View status details for** link to see the new service that was created.
