

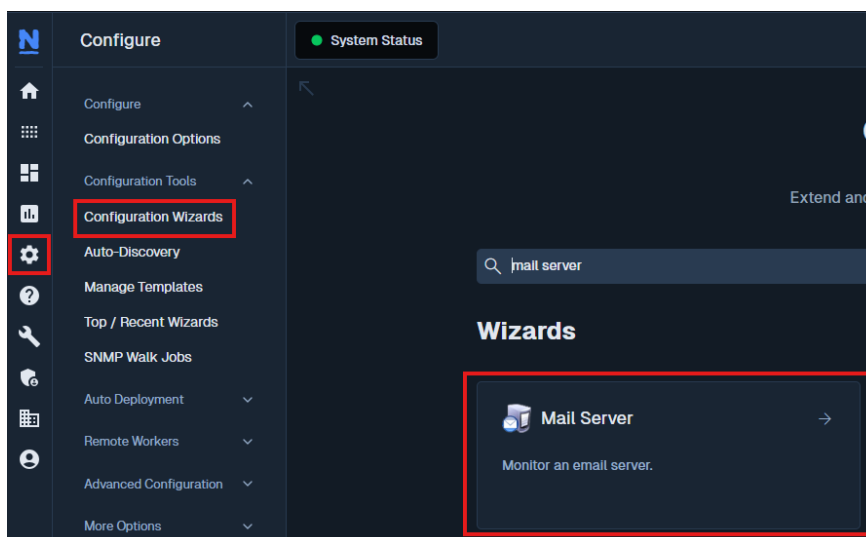
How To Use The Mail Server Wizard In Nagios XI 2024 And 2026

Purpose

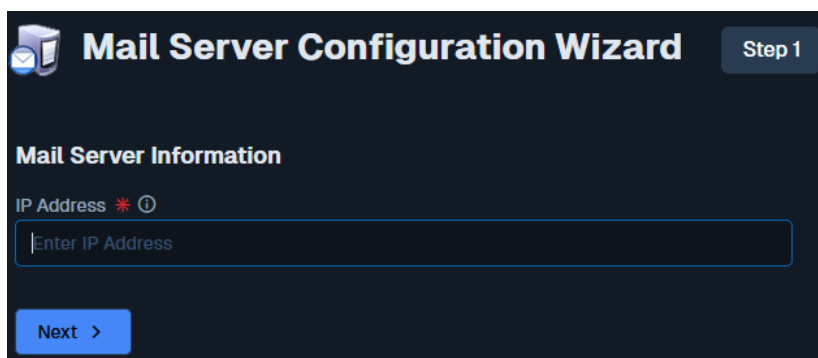
This document explains how to monitor Mail Servers with Nagios XI.

Using the Mail Server Wizard

1. To begin using the Mail Server wizard navigate to **Configure > Configuration Wizards**, search for 'Mail Server', and click the **Mail Server Wizard**.



2. In **Step 1** of the wizard, enter the IP address or FQDN of the Mail Server, then click **Next**.

3. In **Step 2** of the wizard, select the services you would like to monitor.

4. Complete the wizard by choosing the required options in **Step 3 – Step 5**.
