
How To Use The Nagiostats Wizard In Nagios XI 2024 And 2026

Purpose

This document explains how to use the Nagiostats Wizard in Nagios XI to monitor key performance statistics related to the Nagios Core engine that powers Nagios XI's monitoring, including metrics such as the number of active and passive checks being run and check latency.

Using the Nagiostats Wizard

1. Navigate to **Configure > Configuration Wizards** and search for 'stats', then click the **Nagiostats Wizard.**





2. In **Step 1** you'll most likely leave the **Host Name** as localhost, but you can change this if you want these checks to populate under a different host name. Click **Next** to proceed.



3. In **Step 2**, select the checks you want to monitor and their warning and critical thresholds. When you are finished click **Next**.

4. Complete the wizard by choosing the required options in **Step 3 – Step 5**.

To finish up, click on **Finish** in the final step of the wizard. This will create the new host and services and begin monitoring.

Once the wizard applies the configuration, click the **View status details** for link to see the new service that was created.
