

## Overview

This document describes the licensing policy for Nagios XI.

## Target Audience

This document is intended for use by Nagios XI Administrators, IT managers, and licensing departments and personnel.

## Licensing Overview

Each Nagios XI license key may be used on a primary monitoring server, as well as a disaster recovery server and test server as described below.

Organizations that require a single Nagios XI license key to be used on more servers than allowed by this policy should contact the Nagios sales team for additional licenses or activations.

## Disaster Recovery Servers

Each Nagios XI license key may be used on one (1) separate monitoring server that is designated as a disaster recovery (DR) instance, as long as the following condition is met:

- The DR instance is in non-operational mode (e.g. it is not actively monitoring hosts and services), except when it assumes operation when the primary monitoring server fails.

## Development and Testing Servers

Each Nagios XI license key may be used on one separate server that is designated as a development or test instance, as long as the following condition is met:

- The test server is used to test new versions of Nagios XI, and is not used to provide primary monitoring and notifications services for hosts and services.

## License Upgrades

Customer who wish to upgrade their Nagios XI license to support a larger node count, may do so by contacting our sales team. The license upgrade fee is the difference between the regular price of the old and new license levels.
