



## Licensing Overview

Each Nagios XI license key allows for three installs; one as the primary monitoring server, as well as a backup/failover server and a testing environment server as described below. Only one install may be actively monitoring at any given time.

Organizations that require a single Nagios XI license key to be used on more servers than allowed by this policy should contact the Nagios sales team for additional licenses or activations.

## Disaster Recovery Servers

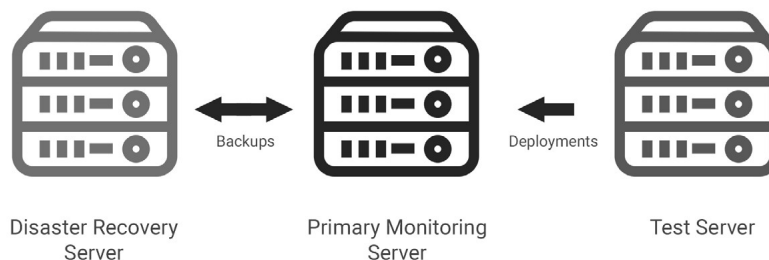
Each Nagios XI license key may be used on one (1) separate monitoring server that is designated as a backup/failover instance, as long as the following condition is met:

- The backup/failover instance is in non-operational mode (e.g. it is not actively monitoring hosts and services), except when it assumes operation when the primary monitoring server fails.

## Development and Testing Servers

Each Nagios XI license key may be used on one separate server that is designated as a development or test instance, as long as the following condition is met:

- The test server is used to test new versions, plugins, and configurations, and is not used to provide production host and service monitoring or notification.



## High Availability Environments

Customers who wish to upgrade their Nagios XI license to support a larger node count may do so by contacting our sales team. The license upgrade fee is the difference between the regular price of the old and new license levels.
